

#### WHAT IS THE BOOK ABOUT?

- The books in this series do not deal with theoretical or practical questions having to do with pictorial themes or media using a systematic and academic approach. In this series the focus is different; it deals with subjects and responds to questions that often trouble painters who are still lacking in experience. And very possibly it can expand the knowledge of those who have had more practice.
- | These are theoretical books organized in various chapters all relating to the main theme. In each chapter there are pages on

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theory and, at the end, a practical exercise on a technique that is of particular interest. There are also pages summarizing the effects and an illustrated glossary that shows different textures and finishes. To round off each chapter there is an explanation of how a famous artist achieved a certain pictorial effect related to the subject.

The exposition uses an open layout, with short, easy to understand texts, precisely what is necessary to present what is to be explained and to provide other details, since the objective is to make it possible for the process to be understood through images.


Example of a theme page, designed to explain the fundamental techniques of painting and the tricks.
